

AUDAX RANDONNEUR REGULATIONS

- Safe cycling is our prime concern
- Bikes must be perfectly roadworthy and a bike check will be carried out at each start of the brevets
- Rear lights are compulsory for all rides, while front lights are compulsory for rides as of 300km onwards
- Reflective jacket is recommended, and will be compulsory for PBP qualifiers in 2010 and 2011
- Participants must have a valid third party insurance cover, valid in Singapore and Malaysia
- Participants must be in proper physical condition, not to endanger themselves or the group. A periodical medical check is advised every 6 months, and a medical certificate is required for participation to PBP.
- AUDAX Randonneur rides are following a specific route and riders must not cut, deviate from this route, or their brevet will not be delivered and ride will be invalidated
- Participants must collect stamps at locations indicated as "Controle" on route directions, to be stamped on the "brevet card" as a proof of passage.
- Card will be dropped at longhouse food court in the designated box, and any missing stamp will lead to invalidation of the brevet
- We ride in an organized group, never more than two abreast
- We respect the other road users and show good manner
- Passport, green card and all valid immigration documents required to cross the Sing/Malaysia borders are required to attend the official brevets.
- Audax Randonneur Singapore rides are "allure Libre" this means that all riders are free to complete the Brevets within the stipulated time at their preferred speed
- We ride in friendly groups, and MUST not leave Audax participants riding by themselves unless agreed together
- Assistance car is allowed at every check point, but is not allowed to follow participants during the ride, or assist participants in between check points unless force majeure case, or abandon, such as : mechanical damage beyond repair, crash, medical emergency.
